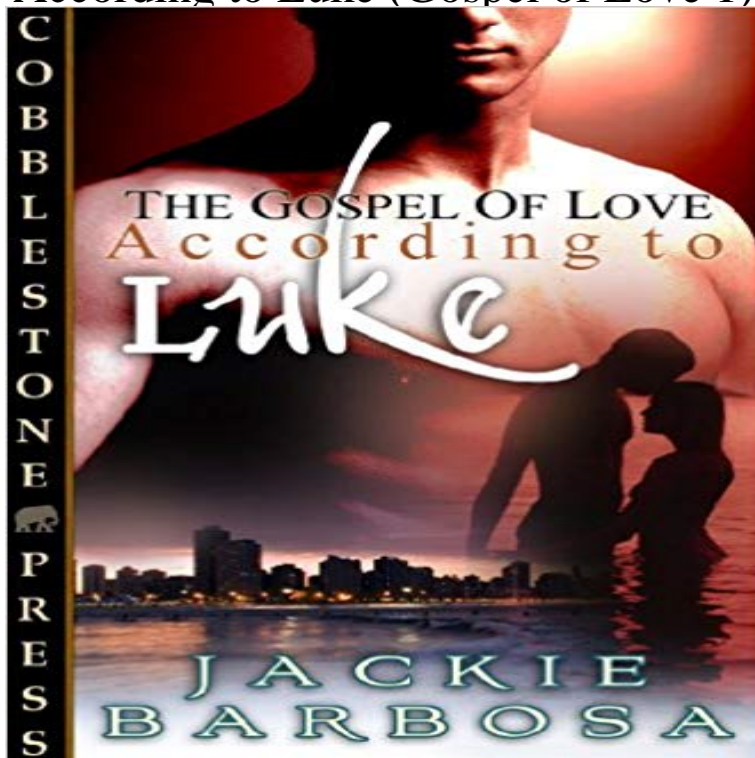


According to Luke (Gospel of Love 1)
