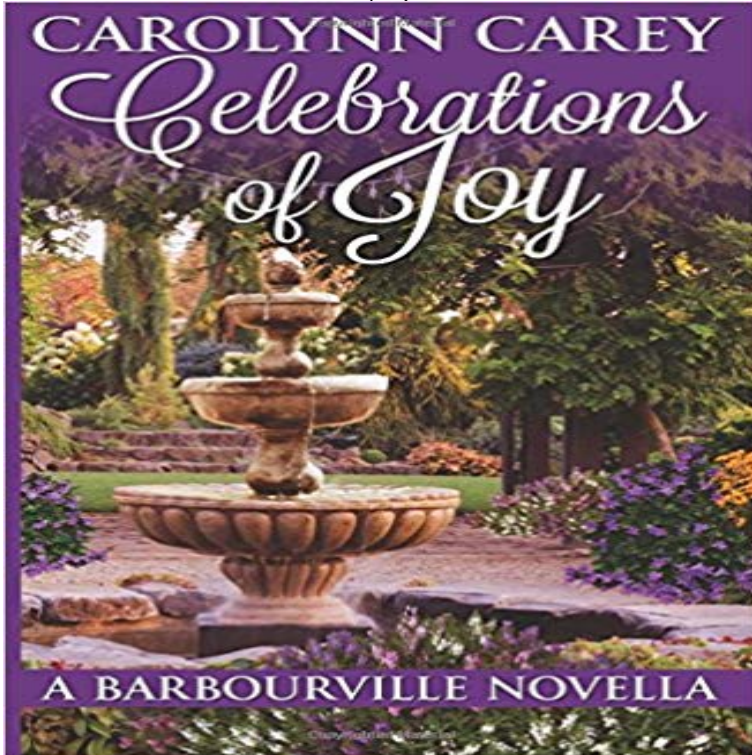


## Celebrations of Joy (The Barbourville Series)
