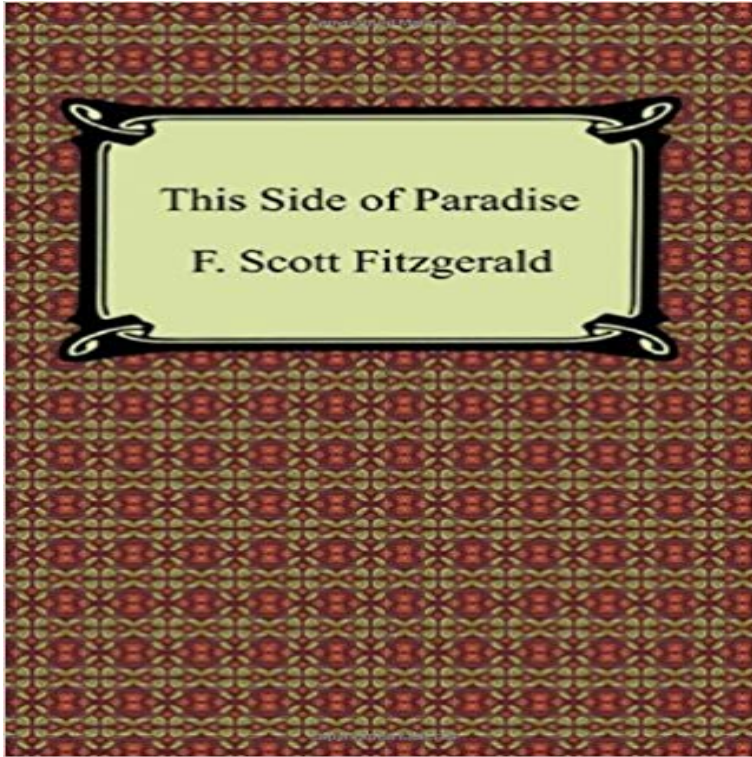


This Side of Paradise
